

UNOCAL

COMPOSITION: Each tablet of Unocal contains Calcium Citrate 950 mg (equivalent to elemental calcium) 200 mg, Vitamin D3 200 I.U, Folic Acid 2.5 mg, Zinc 5 mg, Magnesium hydroxide (equivalent to elemental magnesium) 100 mg. **DESCRIPTION:** Unocal is a combination product of calcium, vitamin D, zinc, folic acid and magnesium. **THERAPEUTIC INDICATIONS:** As a dietary supplement in adolescence, pregnancy, lactation and postmenopausal women. **DOSAGE** As directed by physician. **CONTRAINDICATIONS:** Children under 12 years of age, High levels of calcium in the blood (hypercalcaemia), Kidney stones (nephrolithiasis), Severe kidney failure, Very high levels of calcium in the urine (severe hypercalciuria), Allergy to one or any of its ingredients. **WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS :** Pregnancy: Daily intake should not exceed 1500 mg calcium and 600 IU cholecalciferol (15µg vitamin D). Lactation: Calcium and vitamin D3 pass into breast milk. **DRUG INTERACTIONS:** If the amount of calcium in the blood becomes too high, calcium enhances the effects of digitalis glycosides on the heart. Thiazide diuretics can increase the amount of calcium in the body. Calcium salts may reduce the absorption of Tetracycline, doxycycline, minocycline, Some quinolone antibiotics, e.g ciprofloxacin, norfloxacin, Iron preparations, Bisphosphonates, Thyroxine, Sodium fluoride. To avoid this, the calcium dose should be separated from these medicines by at least four hours. **ADVERSE REACTIONS:** All ingredients are well tolerated however constipation, diarrhea, pain in abdominal area, flatulence, nausea, skin rashes have also been reported.
